*“My son Ollie started at St Francis in 2018. I sent him to this school because I had attended this Primary School in 1999.*

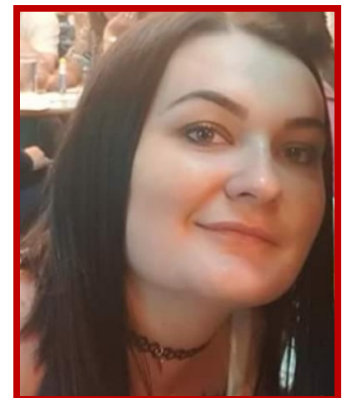
*My time at St Francis was amazing – the school made me ready for high school and taught me the valuable life skills I use today. And that’s the experience I want for my child.*
