CORONAVIRUS



Last Thursday, the Government announced that we are moving from the Contain phase of the coronavirus action plan and into the Delay phase, in response to the ongoing COVID-19 outbreak.

To support the delay of the spread of the virus, the Department for Health and Social Care has asked anyone who shows certain symptoms to stay at home and avoid all but essential contact with others for 7 days.

The symptoms are:

⇒ **A high temperature (37.8 degrees and above)**

⇒ **A new, continuous cough**

You do not need to call NHS 111 to stay at home. If your symptoms worsen during your stay at home period or are no better after 7 days contact NHS 111 online at 111.nhs.uk or call NHS 111.

Current advice remains in place: no education setting should close in response to a suspected or confirmed COVID-19 case unless advised to do so by Public Health.

Decisions on future advice to schools will be taken based on the latest and best scientific evidence, which at this stage suggests children are a lower risk group.

The most important thing individuals can do to protect themselves is to **wash their hands more often**, for at least 20 seconds, with soap and water - before eating, after coughing and sneezing, after using toilets and travelling on public transport.
