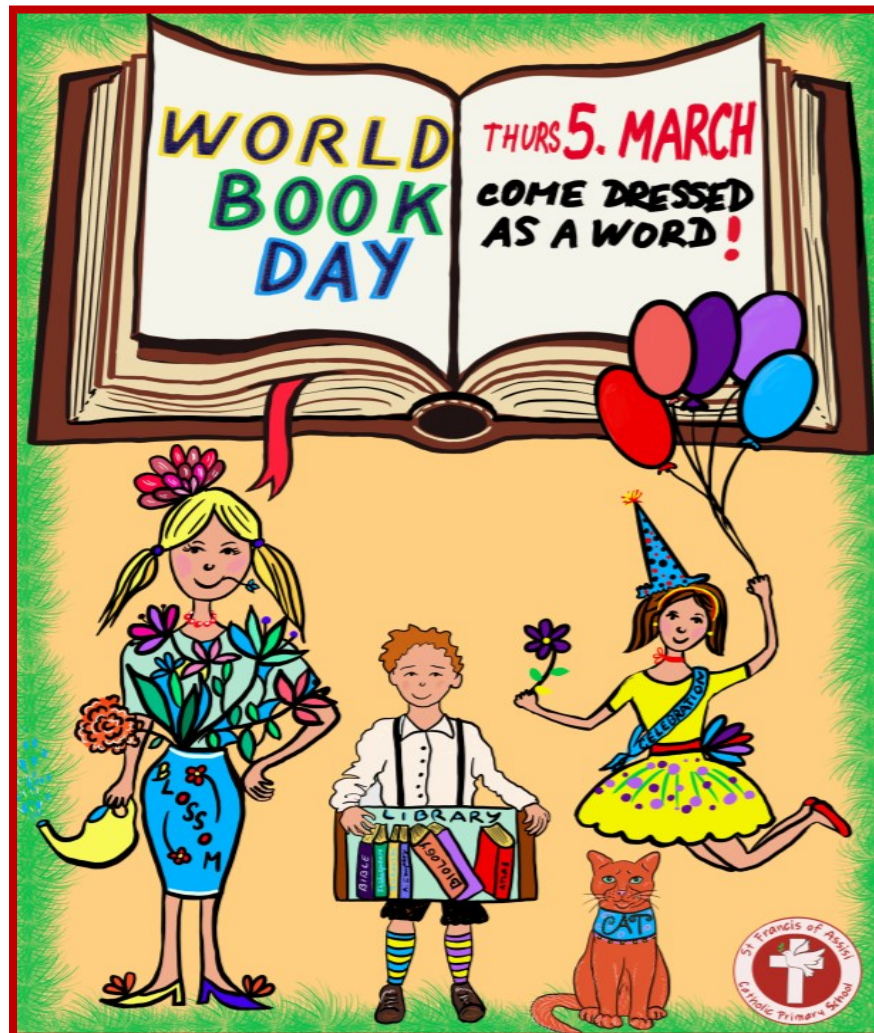

Last week, we began our Lenten journey with a beautiful Ash Wednesday Mass. Thank you for joining us.

This year, we are joining the CAFOD Lent Appeal - and encouraging children, staff and parents to give up something for Lent. Children can put the money saved in a special CAFOD box and bring to assembly every Monday.

Similarly to previous years, children will be able to spend their pennies and have lots of fun during "Good Shepherd" fundraising, when classes will take turns to organise and run special afternoon activities, on the following Thursdays:

Y2 & Y6 (12 March) Y1 & Y4 (19 March) Y3 & Y5 (26 March)

In order to engage in prayers and learn the Easter story, all children will make Holy Easter cards and make their special Lenten promises.
