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### Notes

Monday: Practise reading words containing 'igh'. Write the following words on pieces of paper and hide them around a room in your house. Can the children find the words and read them by segmenting and blending?

Tuesday: Practise reading our sight words by playing this game

Wednesday: Practise reading words containing the 'ai' digraph by playing this game.

<https://new.phonicsplay.co.uk/resources/phase/2/dragons-den> Press 'Phase 3' and then press '+ai' to set up the game. Children can then read the words on the eggs and decide if they are real words or fake words.

Thursday: Write as many words as possible using the 'ai' digraph and 'igh' digraph. Children can then have a go at putting these words into a sentence
