You need to try and find the word to match the pictures.

#### Thursday

Practise reading words containing the digraph 'oo'. This can sometimes make an 'oo' sound as in the word book (b-oo-k) and sometimes make an 'oo' sound as in the word pool (p-oo-l). Please listen to the flashcards video which will give further clarity on this.

We teach the children to try both sounds when they are reading, deciding which sound the 'oo' must make based on whether the word makes sense.

Write the following words on pieces of paper and spread them out on the floor. Put some music on. When the music is on they dance, when the music stops they pick up a word card and read it. Repeat until they have read all of the words.
