




## Home Learning - Phonics Wk 20th April

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### Notes

This week in phonics we will be focusing on naming the letters of the alphabet using their traditional names rather than the phonics sounds.

Monday:

Watch and join in with our Boom Shake the Alphabet song. <https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=Emb2yvwAHtc> Make sure you teach your grown ups how to do the dance!

Tuesday:

Look at all of the different alphablocks! <https://www.bbc.co.uk/iplayer/episodes/b01cz0p1/alphablocks?seriesId=p0872vz3> Can you say the letter names and the sounds for each character? Which letter is your favourite? Can you draw a picture of things that begin with your favourite letter? Don't forget to say the letter name and the sound!

Wednesday:

Watch and join in with alphabet song sung by the Fruity Band. <https://learnenglishkids.britishcouncil.org/songs/the-abc-fruity-band> Can you find some fruit in your house? What letters of the alphabet do your fruit start with? You could use the fruit to make your own fruity band. Can you help your fruit to sing the alphabet song? Maybe you could record a video of your fruity band singing the alphabet?

Thursday:

Watch and join in with the CBeebies alphabet song. It's very catchy so you will be singing it all day! <https://www.bbc.co.uk/iplayer/episode/p06r1zt2/sing-with-cbeebies-series-1-1-we-love-the-alphabet> Make sure you dance along! Write some of the letters of the alphabet on pieces of paper and spread them out on the floor. Play a game where you say one of the letter names and your child has to run to the right letter on the floor. You could even swap places and play with your child saying the letter names.

Friday:
