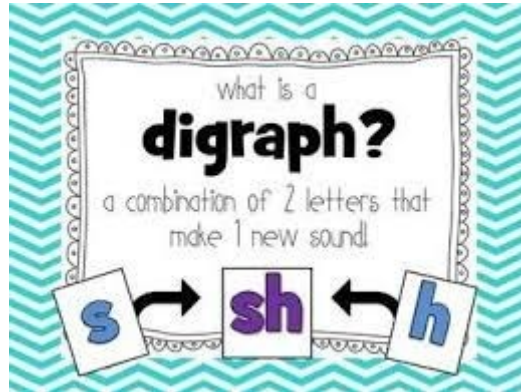

Monday -

Choose the digraph you want to practise from the menu and get reading! Encourage your child to locate digraph first to make reading easier.
