- I can record a drawing in my sketchbook.



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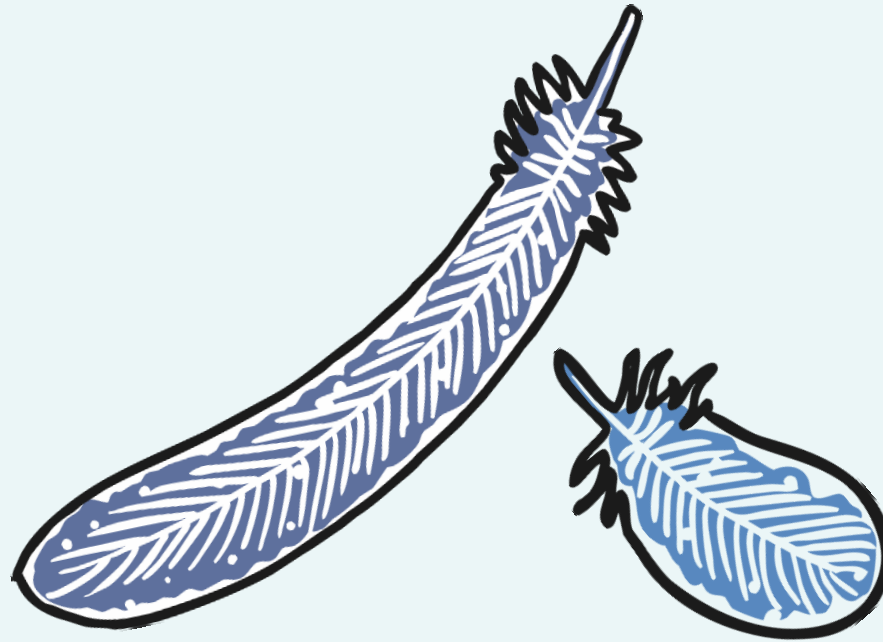
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Comparing Feathers

Can you think of 5 words to describe them?





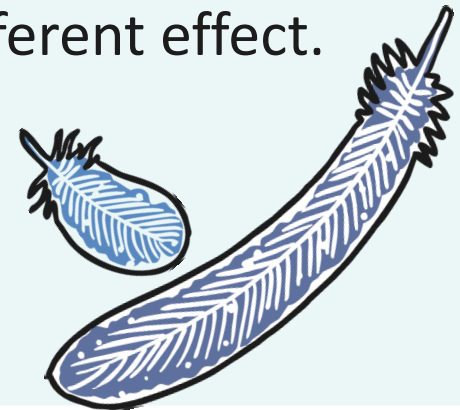
Sketching Feathers
