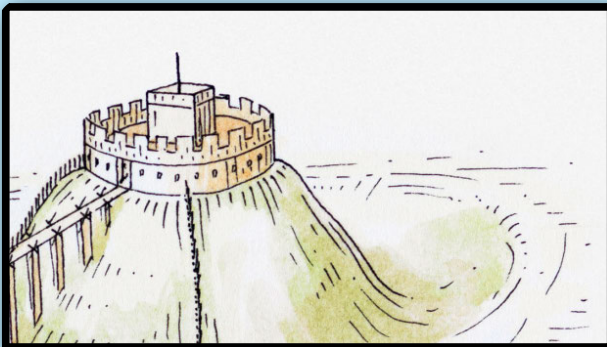
Norman Castles



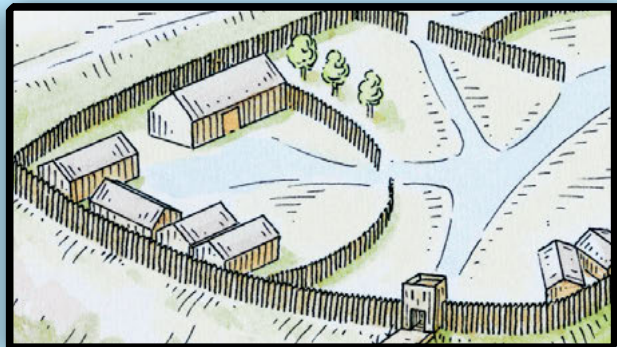
The Normans built **motte and bailey** castles first because they were quick and easy to build.



The Normans built **keep and bailey** castles later on. They were much harder to build but were much stronger.



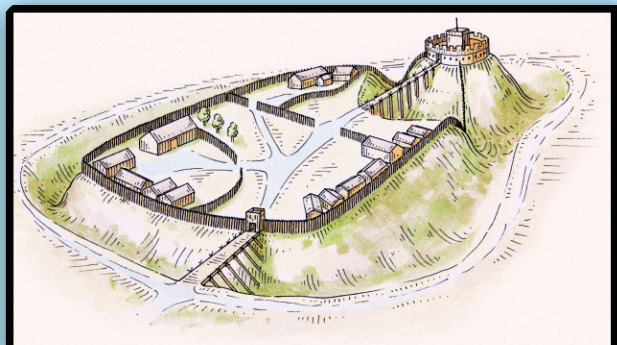
The **motte** is the mound that the castle sits on. It has steep sides so attackers would not be able to get to the castle easily.



The **bailey** is the area at the bottom of the **motte**. The army and workers would have lived there in small huts.



The **keep** was a stone tower. It was normally on a hill and would have been used as a look-out post.

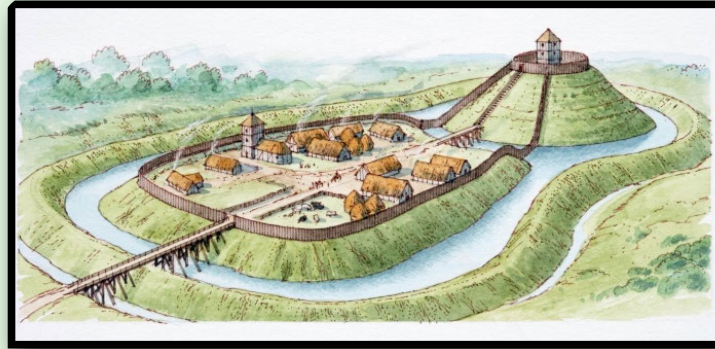


The whole area would have had a **fence** or a **wall** around it. This would have kept out attackers.

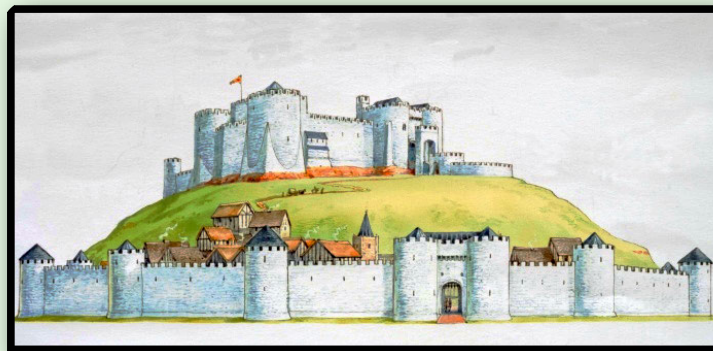
