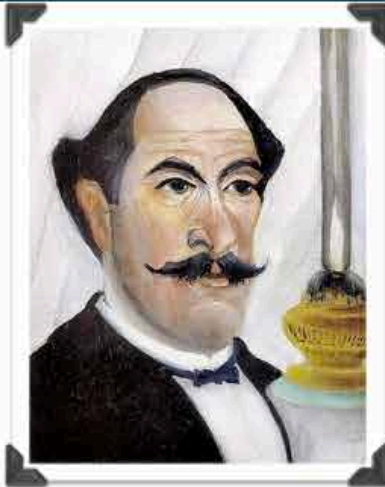


Henri Rousseau: Key Features

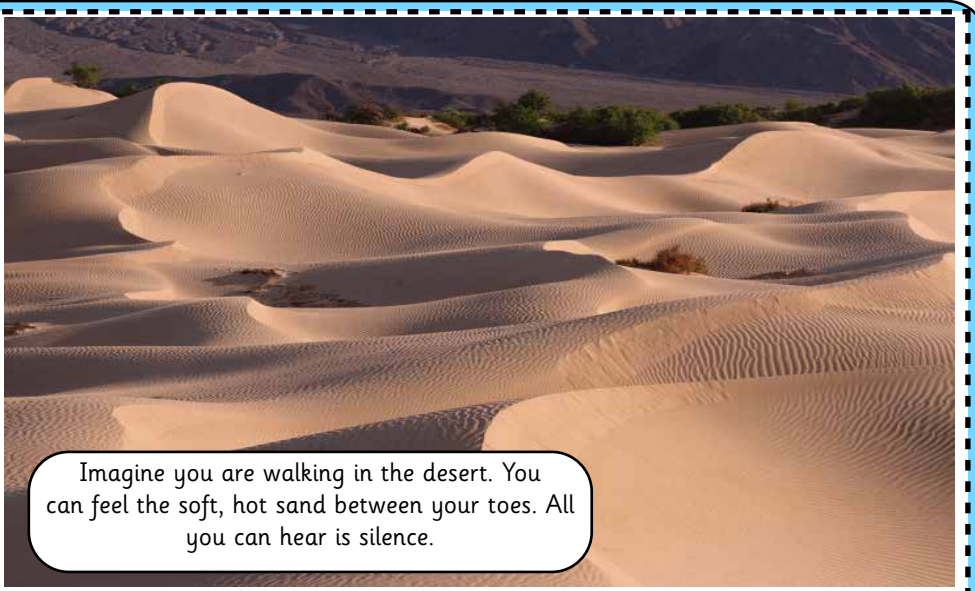

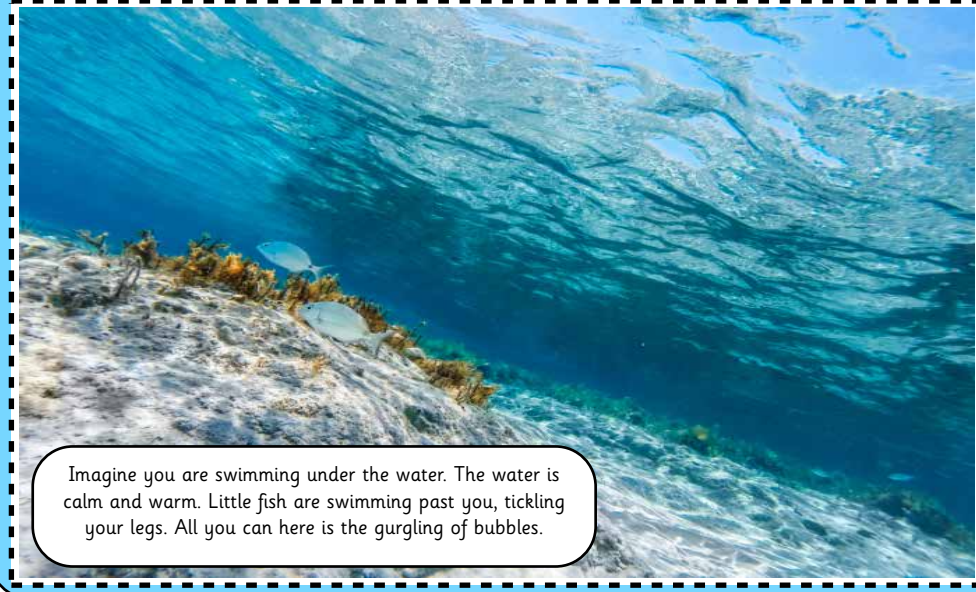

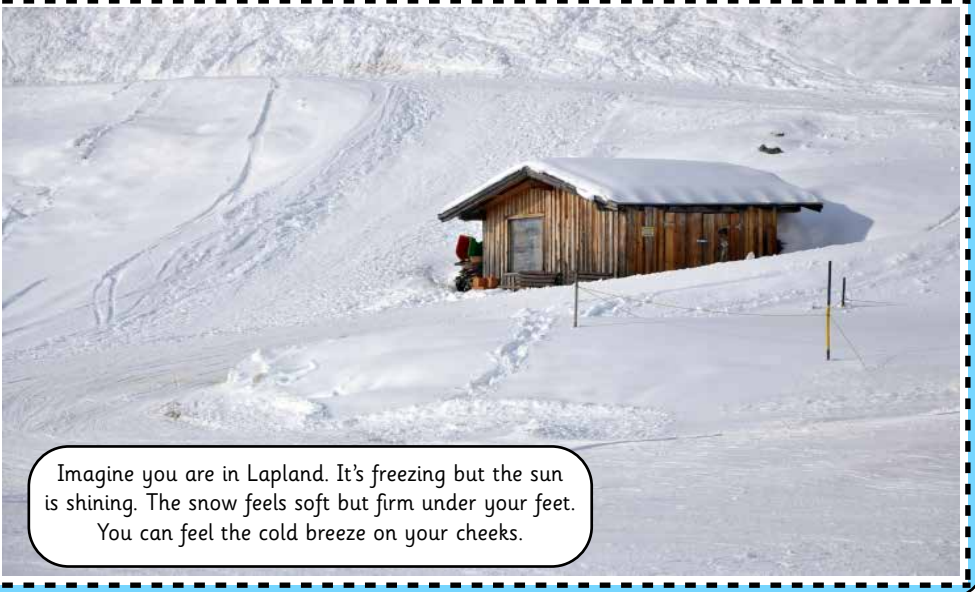
Imagine you are floating in space. All you can see in the darkness are thousands of stars and big glowing planets.
