Adverbs

An adverb is a word that describes a verb, an adjective or another adverb.

They describe how, when, where. This section will focus on adverbs that explain how, as these help to describe a character's emotions and resulting actions, movements and speech. They can also be used when using personification.

EXCITED, HAPPY

- * Excitedly, eagerly, enthusiastically, vivaciously, effusively
- * Quickly, loudly, energetically, jauntily

DETERMINED
