Despite the local lockdown, schools are remaining open, ensuring the children are continuing their very important education.

### **Here are just a few reminders, to make sure we are keeping each other safe:**

- ⇒ Parents are encouraged to wear a face mask, when dropping off and collecting their children.
- ⇒ Children must have a pair of indoor shoes to change into, to avoid mud being brought into the classrooms.
