Dear Parents,

As I am sure you are aware, that new national restrictions apply from today. This has implications for **collection and drop off arrangements**.

As set out in the Government guidelines, parents are able to form a child-care bubble with **one** other household for the purposes of informal child-care, where the child is 13 or under. This applies to dropping off, collection and going to other children’s houses for tea/play dates etc. There **cannot be more than one other household** dropping off or collecting your children during this period of restrictions.

Thank you for everything you are doing to keep the children, staff and school community as safe as possible at this time and I would like to take this opportunity to remind you all of the following:

- ⇒ Please arrive promptly for your drop off time (8.40am or 8.50am)
- ⇒ There should be only ONE adult dropping off/collecting
- ⇒ Please remember to socially distance around the school community
- ⇒ Although it is not a legal requirement for you to wear masks outside, we encourage all parents to do so, if possible
- ⇒ Please be patient at home time and do not call your child’s name. The children are called by the teachers, to ensure everyone’s safety.
- ⇒ Do NOT send your child to school if they are unwell or showing any symptoms of Covid-19. Call 119 or your doctor instead.
