RE: The Mystery of God - We will learn what a mystery is. Why did God choose Mary and Joseph to do such a special job?

English: Writing – The Night Gardener by Terry Fan We will be learning about narrative writing and how to write a diary entry.

Maths: In Maths, we will be focusing on Addition and Subtraction. Can you create your own word problems for addition and subtraction, linking to a subject you find exciting? For example, "David has twenty-one red cars and fourteen yellow cars. How many cars has he got altogether?" Then try different ways to find the answer! PSHE: Celebrating Differences. Learning that we are all different, recognisee what is right and wrong and learn to look after themselves. Learn the ways we are different to our friends.

Science: Animals including humans: Choose one animal of your choice. How does it grow and change from infancy to adulthood? What animal features do you notice and how do they change?

History: Travel & Transport? Children will learn to compare different types of transport now and in the past.

Art: Paper Art: we will learn about different types of paper and their uses for them to make and create. We will plan and create a paper mache sculpture of our own.

Computing: Fix it and Find it. In this topic, we will learn about algorithms by ordering instructions to make things happen and program a robot. We will also start to explore how to debug a program when something goes wrong.

PE: Games and Ball Skills every **Monday –** please come to school in your PE Kit on this day
