Educational Visit to Skelton Grange Environment Centre – Wild History – The Stone Age

To support all the wonderful work we are doing this half term in History we are going on an exciting class trip to **Skelton Grange Environment Centre** on **Tuesday 17th October**. We will be leaving school at **9.30am** and will return by **3pm**. Because much of the trip will take place outside, in a woodland environment, please ensure that your child comes suitably dressed for the weather; School PE uniform must be worn but please provide your child with sensible shoes/trainers that can get muddy and a waterproof coat/jacket, also jogging bottoms must be worn/waterproof trousers if you have them.

- The cost of the trip will be **£15.00**. This will cover the cost to visit the centre and covers the cost of the coach. Details will be posted onto your School Money app for payment.

This day supports the history curriculum 'Changes in Britain from the Stone age to the Iron age' by providing an experience of using stone age skills in a natural setting. The children should come prepared to get muddy and try out some new experiences All activities are fully risk assessed and the children will be supervised by qualified and experienced staff and volunteers from Skelton and school. - **The children will need to bring a packed lunch and their water bottle. Lunch will only be provided where your child is entitled to free school dinners.**
